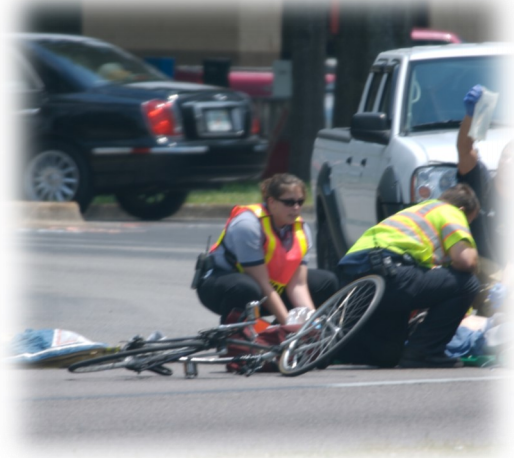

FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA (TMA) SITE VISIT CONCLUDED

Representatives of the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration and Florida Department of Transportation hosted a virtual public meeting on August 11, 2020 at 5:00 pm, followed by virtual meetings with MPO staff and a number of our planning partners on August 12 and 13.

The Federal agencies final remarks at the end of the three-day session were generally favorable and included a number of recommendations regarding the 2045 LRTP including:

- Emphasize multi-modalism; add information regarding airport long range plans, provide more information on bicycle and pedestrian and transit enhancement projects
- Add a graphic describing the plans and studies that contribute to the development of the LRTP and how often they are updated; examples include the Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan, Transit Development Plan (Major Update), Local Roads Safety Plan, Transportation System Performance Report & Action Plan, and Congestion Management Process
- Add financial detail related to current Transportation Improvement Program in Cost Feasible Plan spreadsheets in addition to project information provided in the Existing + Committed Roadway Network

The final report is anticipated in December 2020. MPO staff wishes to thank all who participated in the public meeting and site visit interviews!
