Copeland Avenue Roundabout Sidewalk Improvements,

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT: EVERGLADES CITY SIDEWALKS!

New sidewalks and crosswalk markings will be installed at the roundabout as part of the Copeland Avenue Sidewalk project in Everglades City. Improvements will enhance pedestrian safety by adding sidewalks, crosswalk markings, and enhancing setbacks. Existing lighting and utilities will not be impacted by the improvements. FDOT is the project sponsor and will be performing the improvements on behalf of Everglades City. The project is scheduled to start in 2022.

MPO BOARD APPROVES TIP AMENDMENT

ADVANCING PROJECT AND FUNDING FOR I-75 AT SR 951 ULTIMATE INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS

The MPO Board voted unanimously to approve the TIP amendment at their October 8th MPO board meeting. On October 7th the Citizens and Technical Advisory Committees voted to endorse the TIP amendment. The TIP amendment authorizes the use of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) Federal Stimulus funds to advance the I-75 at SR 951 project from FY 2025 to FY 2022. The total amount of funding is \$81,961,590. FDOT District 1 Secretary, LK Nandam noted that it was constant collaboration and focus on this project that allowed the District to put it forward as the number one priority and receive the stimulus money. MPO Board members were pleased to approve this amendment. Chair Middelstaedt noted how exciting it is to move forward a project by 3 years. Commissioner Solis thanked Anne McLaughlin, Collier MPO Executive Director, along with the County and FDOT for working together to move the project forward and for all their hard work.
