As reported by Tomas Rodriguez in the Naples Daily News on June 16, 2022, an early estimate released by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration shows the highest number of road deaths in 16 years. Greg Bueno, spokesperson for the Florida Highway Patrol in southwest Florida, urges residents and visitors to drive responsibly, put your phones down, drive sober, wear a seatbelt, and have patience.
