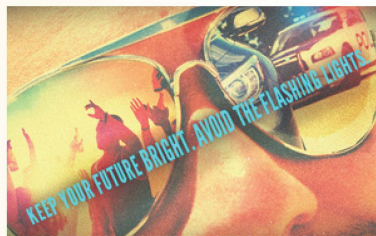


August 3, 2023, Collier MPO & Lee MPO joint Technical Advisory & Citizens Advisory Committees workshops.
