Executive Summary

Approve an Amendment to the Collier MPO 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (add Moving Florida Forward Funding for I-75/Immokalee Interchange Improvements)

OBJECTIVE: For the MPO Board to approve an amendment to the 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and the authorizing resolution to add the Immokalee Interchange Improvement project, funded by the Moving Florida Forward Infrastructure Initiative, to the LRTP Cost Feasible Plan (CFP) to maintain planning consistency with FDOT's FY 2026-2030 Work Program.

CONSIDERATIONS: MPO staff has prepared an amendment to the 2045 LRTP to add the Immokalee Interchange Improvement project identified in FDOT's FY 2026-2030 Work Program with funding from the Moving Florida Forward Infrastructure Initiative and recent Federal and State appropriations and project phases added or changed. The proposed addition is listed below and shown in red font on the attached CFP – Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) Table 6-2, page 6-4 of the 2045 LRTP (**Attachment 1**). Fiscal constraint is maintained by the addition of Moving Florida Forward funds and other State revenues for the SIS CFP.

The LRTP Amendment adds the following project:

• FPID No. 452544-4: Immokalee Interchange. Major Interchange Improvements. Managed by FDOT. PE, ROW, RRU, Design Build FY26-28. \$71.5 million

The MPO is following the LRTP amendment public involvement process outlined in the MPO's Public Participation Plan notice requirements in that this Amendment has been:

- Posted for review by the TAC and CAC;
- Public comment period announced on the MPO website; and
- Distributed via e-mail to applicable list-serve(s).

The comment period began on April 21, 2025, and ends with the MPO Board meeting on May 9, 2025.

Authorizing Resolution 2025-05, including Exhibits 1 and 2, is shown in Attachment 2.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS: The Technical and Citizens Advisory Committees voted to endorse the Amendment at their meetings on April 28, 2025.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approve the 2045 LRTP Amendment and Authorizing Resolution 2025-05.

MPO RESOLUTION No. 2025-05 A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION APPROVING AMENDMENT TO THE 2045 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, State and federal statutes, rules and regulations require that each designated Metropolitan Planning Organization develop and adopt a Long Range Transportation Plan ("LRTP") and set forth the procedures for doing so; and

WHEREAS, the Collier Metropolitan Planning Organization's (the "MPO") LRTP may require amending as authorized and required by 23 C.F.R. Part 450 Section 104 and by F.S. § 339.175(6),(7), and (13); and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") added Federal Project Number ("FPN") 452544-4, as part of the Moving Florida Forward initiative for Interstate 75 to the FY2026-2030 Work Program, as shown in Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has determined that the Amendment is necessary to include in the MPO's LRTP to ensure consistency with FDOT's Work Program, as shown in Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the MPO announced the LRTP Amendment on its website, distributed it via e-mail to various list-serves, and followed all of the steps of its Public Participation Plan through the expiration of the public comment period, which terminated with the MPO's meeting on May 9, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has prepared the proposed LRTP Amendment for this project and determined that it is in accordance with all required State and federal procedures, rules and regulations, including but not limited to the FDOT's MPO Administrative Manual.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Collier Metropolitan Planning Organization that:

- 1. The 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan Amendment set forth in Exhibits 1 and 2 is hereby adopted.
- 2. The Collier Metropolitan Planning Organization's Chairman is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution certifying the MPO Board's approval of the Amendment to the 2045 Long Range Plan for transmittal to FDOT and the Federal Highway Administration.
