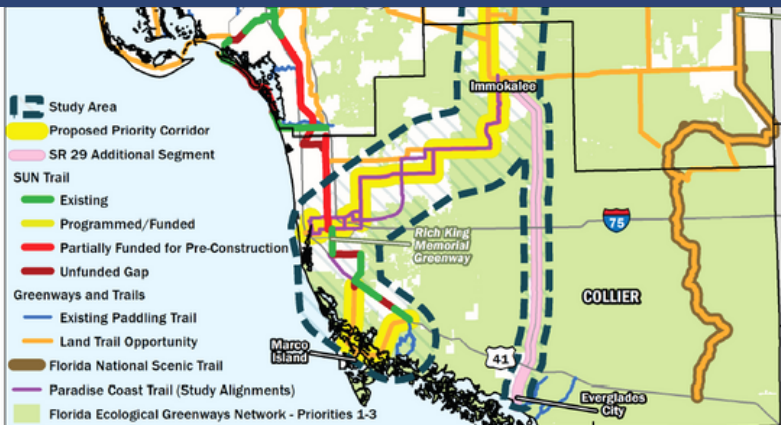


COLLIER TO POLK REGIONAL TRAIL PD&E BEGINS

The Collier to Polk Regional Trail Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) study has begun and is estimated to be completed in 2026.

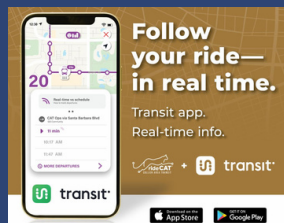
