Drafts of the Safety Action Plan (SAP), developed in coordination with TY Lin, and the Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan (BPMP), prepared with Capital Consulting, are now available for public review and comment. Both plans will inform the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), scheduled for adoption on December 11, 2025.

Collier County PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Frank Whiteman Boulevard, Cooper Drive, Illinois Drive, and Wisconsin Drive Sidewalks Project

A public information meeting will be held in an openhouse format on Monday, August 18, from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. at the Collier County Growth Management Community Development Department, located at 2800 N. Horseshoe Drive, Rooms 609/610, Naples, FL 34112.

About the Project:

The project includes the installation of new 5-foot-wide concrete sidewalk segments along the north side of Frank Whiteman Boulevard, Cooper Drive, Illinois Drive, and Wisconsin Drive, spanning from 10th Street North to 14th Street North.

In coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the project has reached the 60% design stage. Final design and permitting are anticipated to be completed by the end of this year, with construction tentatively scheduled to begin in fall 2026.


