



## FDOT DISTRICT 1 PROPOSES 5-YEAR WORK PROGRAM

### PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR FUTURE TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS IN DISTRICT 1 | DECEMBER 9-13, 2024

The Florida Department of Transportation, District One, has scheduled a Public Hearing to present the Draft Tentative 5-Year Work Program. The Draft Tentative Work Program lists transportation system improvements scheduled for fiscal years 2025/26 through 2029/30. There are 3 ways to participate.

1. Formal Presentation: presented at two FDOT locations simultaneously on Wednesday, December 11, 2024 10am-12pm at the Bartow Office, 801 N. Broadway Avenue and the Fort Myers office, 10041 Daniels Parkway. Virtual participation is also available: [Register Here](#)
2. Public Hearing: FDOT representatives will be available by appointment December 9 through December 13, 2024 during business hours at District Offices to review project materials with members of the public. Call the Bartow office at 863-519-2907 or the Fort Myers office at 239-225-1900 to schedule an appointment.

Public libraries within the FDOT District One territory provide access to computers and internet service during library hours. The ePublic Hearing will be open and available on Monday, December 11, 2024.
