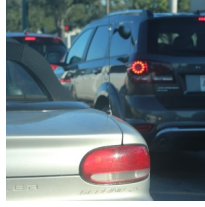

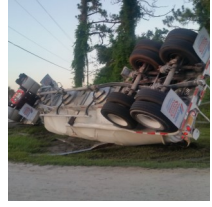

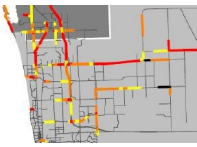

## LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP)



**Alternative Scenario Development and Testing Underway:** FDOT is partnering with MPOs by running the Planning Regional Model against a series of roadway network alternatives and 2045 forecasted growth characteristics. Beginning with the Existing + Committed Network, FDOT and the MPO moved on to test Alternative 1 which evaluated the adopted 2040 LRTP needs network. The MPO is submitting Alternative 2 on May 15 to meet FDOT's deadline. Alternative 2 includes additional capacity improvements to reduce the congestion forecasted by the model. The Citizens Advisory Committee and Technical Advisory Committee are meeting (remotely) on May 18th and will provide input on the testing conducted thus far and suggest additional network alternatives for testing.

**Transit Development Plan**— Tindale Oliver is the consultant. Josephine Medina is the MPO's Project Manager. The TDP will serve as the transit element of the 2045 LRTP. The project timeline, Public Participation Plan are on the website. The TDP Technical Working Group met on May 13, 2020 and were presented online survey results and initial network alternatives. A second online survey to obtain thoughts on proposed mobility improvements will be going live late May/ June and will be posted on the website.

**Transportation Disadvantaged Service Plan Minor Update**— The TDSP identifies the types of paratransit service that will be provided for the community and the rates that will be assessed for that service. The 14-day public comment period for the minor update will begin on May 20 and end June 3. The Local Coordinating Board (LCB) for the Transportation Disadvantaged will consider approval of the TDSP Minor Update at their June meeting after discussion of all comments received. The TDSP Minor Update will be posted on the website for review.

**Transit Impact Analysis**— Tindale Oliver is the consultant. Brandy Otero is the MPO's Project Manager. The project was requested by Collier County Public Transportation and Neighborhood Enhancement Division and funded by the MPO. It is intended to assess the impact of development on the transit network. The consultant is completing the draft report. Advisory Committee presentations will be scheduled for late Summer/ early Fall. The project completion date has been extended until December 31, 2020. View the project scope at the link provided.

**Park and Ride Study**— Jacobs is the consultant. Josephine Medina is the MPO's Project Manager. The Park and Ride Study will identify prime locations, site plan considerations and planning level cost estimates that will aid the County and MPO Board in prioritizing future project expenditures. 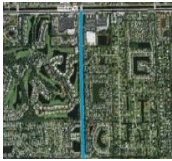
**Unified Planning Work Program FY21 - 22**

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN AMENDMENT**



The MPO is in the process of amending its Public Participation Plan to address emergencies such as the current COVID-19 pandemic along with a number of updates and clarifications recommended by FHWA reviewers. The CAC and TAC will review the amendment at their meetings on May 18th. The Board will take action at their June 12th meeting. The mandatory 45-day public comment period ends on May 22nd, however staff will continue to accept comments up until the Board meeting packet is posted.
