A successful and informative joint workshop of the Collier MPO Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee and the Lee MPO Bicycle & Pedestrian Coordinating Committee was held on Tuesday, October 24, 2023 at The Collaboratory in Fort Myers.

Several exciting upcoming projects were discussed, including the highly anticipated <u>Marco Island Loop Trail</u>, the proposed <u>Collier to Polk Regional Trail</u>, and the <u>US Bike Route 15 Expansion</u>. There were also discussions on traffic crashes, traffic enforcement, and micromobility regulations.

Sgt. Horowitz with Collier County Sheriff's Office spoke about how traffic enforcement statutes need to be updated to keep up with transportation technology and that the sheriff's office does its best to educate the community about pedestrian and bicyclist safety. GOLDEN GATE PARKWAY BRIDGE OVER SANTA BARBARA CANAL NOW OPEN

The newly constructed Golden Gate Parkway Bridge over the Santa Barbara Canal is open to through traffic. The bridge replacement project which began in October 2022 is at substantial completion which means there are still some punch list items to complete but the good news for the traveling public is that the lane closures are completed and the new four-lane bridge (two lanes eastbound and two lanes westbound) with 12-foot-wide sidewalks in each direction are all open and usable for all.
